The Construction of Vocational Training Centre in Ampara

The UNDP Transition Recovery Programme (TRP) is UNDP Sri Lanka's flagship project for socio-economic recovery of conflict-affected communities. TRP provides integrated support to returnees, host communities and other vulnerable groups with different needs, capacities and aspirations in the conflict-affected and border districts in the North and East of Sri Lanka. The TRP's six key areas of delivery are: 1) Community-based housing development; 2) Micro-finance and micro-enterprise development; 3) Agriculture, fisheries, livestock and alternative livelihoods development; 4) Small-scale community infrastructure; 5) Social transformation for social empowerment and peace-building at the community level; and 6) Community-based environmental management. Incorporated across the six focus areas are the cross-cutting areas of gender empowerment, conflict-sensitive analysis, vulnerability and mine action. The Programme adopts a UN inter-agency approach, and has built partnerships with a range of stakeholders, from government ministries and local government agencies to community-based and non-government organizations.
